

QSO 645 Module Six Journal Guidelines and Rubric

Overview: Journal assignments in this course are private between you and the instructor. In this journal, you will have the opportunity to develop an exam preparation roadmap that you can revisit and use when studying for the PMP® exam. Consider the ideas that were discussed in your study group while completing this assignment. In addition, consider the layout and information that is presented in the *PMBOK® Guide* to help you frame your own individual roadmap.

Note: Refer to the conversation points from your small group to assist you in constructing this assignment.

Prompt: This assignment should include the following **critical elements**:

- Identify key resources that will be useful during your exam preparation, and explain the resources you list.
- Discuss your **study schedule**, which details the amount of time and the location you plan to devote to studying.
- Identify your **strengths and weaknesses** and explain how they influence your test-taking ability.
- Describe **solutions** that will improve your test-taking skills. How do they relate to preparing for the PMP[®] exam?

Guidelines for Submission: Submit assignment as a Word document with double spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, and one-inch margins. Your journal assignment should be one- to two-paragraphs, and any sources should be cited in APA format.
