

PAD 631 Module Five Activity Guidelines and Rubric

Overview: This assignment will help you in identifying and understanding how a vision is put into practice from a public policy perspective.

Prompt: The news director for your television station has given you an assignment to interview the rising senatorial candidate for your state. This candidate has a vision for a new America and has used this vision heavily on the campaign trail. Using the information from the textbook and resources for this module, develop a list of questions that you would ask the candidate during the interview. Provide a rationale for why you selected these questions.

Specifically, the following **critical elements** must be addressed:

- I. Develop a list of **questions** that relate to the candidate’s vision.
- II. Provide a **rationale** for the selection of these questions.

Guidelines for Submission: Your paper must be submitted as a 1- to 2-page Microsoft Word document with double spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, one-inch margins, and sources cited in APA format.
