Impacts of Trade Agreements

Overview: In this assignment, you will be writing a short paper on the impacts of trade agreements on a specific market (you may use the market you are focusing on for your final project). Specifically, your paper should address the following critical elements:

- The benefits of the trade agreement on the economy and market
- How the trade agreement negatively impacts the market
- The impacts on a specific industry and/or product

Guidelines for Submission: Your paper should be 2–3 pages in length (not including title page and reference page) and written in APA style. Be sure to use scholarly references to support your arguments.
